Job Description: Part-time Volunteer Assistant Administrator

Imagine is looking for a part-time assistant administrator (2 afternoons per week: Monday and Thursday 2-5.30pm) to join the team in the next phase of development. The candidate, enthusiastic and responsible, will assist in maintaining the quality of the studio space as well as being involved in the financial management. A 6-month or longer commitment is required.

Tasks would include:

- Help with the monthly cash book management (ex. filing invoices)
- Filing and updating of Bursary Fund account
- Help with maintaining studio equipment, art materials and refreshments stock
